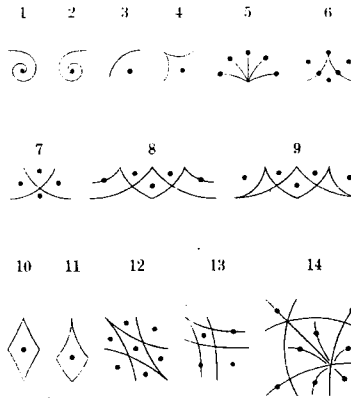

DESIGN FOR A FONT OF PRINTING-TYPE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 12,646, dated December 27, 1881.

Application filed November 17, 1881. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, AUGUST WILL, (assignor
to DAVID WOLFE BRUCE,) of Jersey City, Hud-
son county, New Jersey, have invented and pro-
5 duced a new and original Design for a Font of
Printing-Type, of which the following is a speci-
fication.

The types composing this font are represented
in the accompanying sheet of drawings, which
10 is made up of impressions from the types them-
selves, and shows the exact configuration of

their faces in a series of figures numbered from
1 to 14, inclusive.
