DESIGN FOR A FONT OF PRINTING-TYPE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 12,221, dated April 12, 1881.

Application filed February 24, 1881. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CHARLES E. HEYER, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented and produced a new and original Design for Printing-Types, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof.

10 The character of the design or pattern for a font of ornamental printing-types consists of capitals, lower case, figures, and points.

15 The letter has the design of an old English or black open shaded, which opening is effected by diagonal parallel-running hair-lines inside the letter, with this difference from any other style of letter of its kind, that the character of this alphabet is modernized and more plain, produced by a condensed and heavy faced
20 style, which combines something entirely new and original.

The style of letter is represented by the accompanying typographical impression.

The letter has a heavy black line on left side, and a fine or hair line on the other side, which incloses the opening of the diagonal hair-
25 lines.

The capital letters (as shown on accompanying typographical impression) A B D F H I K L M N P R S U V W X Y Z have a
30 curve, as an ornamental addition, below the bottom line, which is opened, forming a hair-line and a light black line, and is an extension of the bottom curved part of the letter, and terminates in or toward the letter.
