GEORG GIESECKE, OF LEIPSIC, SAXONY, GERMANY.

DESIGN FOR PRINTING-TYPE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 13,831, dated April 3, 1883.

Application filed January 4, 1883. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern :

Be it known that I, GEORG GIESECKE, of Leipsic, in the Kingdom of Saxony, Empire of United Germany, have invented and produced
5 a new and original Design for a Font of Printing-Type, of which the following is a specification.

10 The nature of my design is clearly shown in the accompanying typographic impression, to which reference is made; and it consists of a text-letter shaded on the right and below by a lighter line and ornamented by a series of light curved tendril-like ornaments filling the space between the up and down portions.

The character of the design is preserved in 15 the lower-case, punctuation-marks, and figures, save that the light curved ornaments are omitted.

Having now described my invention, I claim as new—

20 The design for a font of printing-type, as shown and described.
