## DESIGN FOR A FONT OF TYPE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 30,916, dated May 30, 1899.

Application filed March 25, 1899. Serial No. 710,510. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:
Beitknown that I, John F. Cumming, a citizen of the United States, residing at Worcester, in the county of Worcester and State of Massachusetts, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Font of Type, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The drawing shows the capital and small letters, figures, and punctuation-marks of a font of type embodying my new design.

As shown in the drawing, the leading or ma-

terial feature of my design for a font of type 5 consists in producing curves at the junctions of all lines composing the letters which meet at an angle.

The capital letters E and F have their short middle lines and their top and bottom lines

as well as the top line of the letter T curved 20 as shown.

Letters k and R have their lower outstroke curved gradually outward, and the letter Q has the same outward curved stroke.

As peculiar characteristics of the small let- 25 ters, in addition to the curved corners at the junctions of the lines, the letters m and n have curved tops, as shown.

I claim-

The design for a font of type as herein 30 shown and described.
