RUDOLPH GNICHWITZ, OF ASHBOURNE, PENNSYLVANIA.

DESIGN FOR TYPE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 19,081, dated May 7, 1889.

Application filed February 27, 1889. Serial No. 301,425. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, RUDOLPH GNICHWITZ, a citizen of the United States, residing at Ashbourne, in the county of Montgomery and State of Pennsylvania, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Font of Printing-Type, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The leading features of my design for a font of printing-type are the heavy lines of the horizontal portions of the various letters, figures, and characters and fine lines of the vertical portion thereof, the lower-case having the fine lines of the vertical portion coming to a fine point and the cross-dash of nearly all the said letters omitted, the letters of the upper-case having downward extension, being

as shown in A, F, &c., the letters D and L having a curl, as shown, at the top portion thereof, and the letter T having a top curved portion, as shown.

In the accompanying drawing, which represents the letters and characters of a font of type according to my design, the several letters and characters have the respective features as heretofore set forth.

I claim—

The design for a font of type, consisting of the letters and characters having the respective features and form as herein shown and described.
