## DESIGN FOR TYPE.

**SPECIFICATION** forming part of Design No. 18,940, dated February 26, 1889.

Application filed November 30, 1888. Serial No. 292,334. Term of patent 14 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, WILLIAM W. JACKSON, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a new and original Design for a Font of Type, of which the following is a specification.

My invention is fully illustrated in the accompanying typographical impression.

The pronounced design of the characters is the formation of a square-cornered heavy-faced block-letter, the leading features comprising the upper loops of the letters B, P, and R in the upper-case, which are triangular, as shown, while the top of the left-hand vertical line of the letters H and U, upper-case, is inclined, as is also the top of the letter A. The horizontal lines of the letters E, F, L, T, and Z are also beveled, while the tail of the let-

ter J is turned abruptly, and the end is also beveled. The tail of the letter Q is in the form of an abrupt angle.

The lower-case letters and numerals carry out, as far as possible, the features predominating in the upper-case letters.

I claim—

The design for a font of type, substantially as described, and as shown in the accompanying typographical impression.
