DESIGN FOR A FONT OF SCRIPT PRINTING-TYPE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 14,340, dated October 2, 1883.

Application filed August 23, 1883. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM W. JACKSON,
(assignor to MACKELLAR, SMITHS & JORDAN,) 5
of the city and county of Philadelphia, Penn-
sylvania, have invented and produced a new
and original Design for a Font of Printing-
Types, of which the following is a specifica-
tion.

10 The nature of my design is clearly shown
in the accompanying typographic impression,
to which reference is made; and it consists of a
script letter of the running-hand character,
unshaded and unornamented, as shown.

The character of the design is preserved in
the lower-case, the punctuation-marks, the 15
logotypes, and the numerals, as clearly shown.
