## DESIGN FOR A FONT OF PRINTING-TYPE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 14,255, dated September 4, 1883. Application filed July 24, 1883. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM W. JACKSON, (assignor to MacKellar, Smiths & Jordan,) of the city and county of Philadelphia, Penn-5 sylvania, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Font of Printing-Type, of which the following is a specifica-

The nature of my design is clearly shown in to the accompanying typographic impression, to which reference is made; and it consists of a heavy condensed unshaded letter. In the B, D, P, and R the up-and down portion of the letter upon the left hand does not extend to 15 meet the upper cross part of the letter, but terminates a short distance below the same in the inclined side termination, as shown. The inclined side termination is found upon the right hand in the C, E, and L at the top and 20 bottom; in the F, G, and H at the upper right hand, and at the top and bottom of the Jup-on the left hand. Both terminations of the S and the top terminations of the T show the inclined sides. The up-and-down portions of 25 the M are arched, as shown, and the central portion consists of a continuation of these, one upon the right hand and the other upon the left hand, extending downward to a proper point and arched, as shown, while the W is to the reverse of the M.

The character of the design is preserved in

the lower-case, notably in the c, e, s, and t, and in the figures 2, 3, and 4.

In connection with the font are also shown two ornamental adjuncts, one upon the left 35 hand and the other upon the right hand of the figures. The former consists of a series of light lines, with heavy dot-terminations radiating from a common center placed upon the left of a figure composed of two heavy inclined 40 portions, which cross each other. One of these terminates below the point of crossing in a heavy dot, while its opposite end is provided with the inclined side termination above the point of crossing, while in the second heavy 45 portion of the figure the heavy dot is above the point of crossing and the inclined side termination below the same. In the other adjunct a heavy semicircular figure has upon its right hand a series of heavy small spear-head-like 50 ornaments, which are placed so as to follow its configuration, and gradually increase in length as they near the central point.
Having now described my invention, I claim

The design for a font of printing-type, substantially as shown and described.
