DESIGN FOR A FONT OF PRINTING-TYPE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 18,164, dated March 6, 1888.

Application filed February 9, 1888. Serial No. 263,530. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM W. JACKSON, (assignor to the MACKELLAR, SMITHS & JORDAN COMPANY,) of the city and county of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a new Design for a Font of Printing-Type, of which the following is a specification.

The nature of my design is shown in the accompanying typographic impression, to which ro reference is made; and it consists of an orna-

mental letter. The upper portions of all the letters except the B, C, D, G, P, R, and S are ornamented by the short horizontal lines, as shown. In the B, 15 C, D, P, and R the upper portion of the letters is ornamented by a curved line proceeding in the B, D, P, and R from the up-and-down portion of the letters and curved to the right, and in the C from the upper right portion and 20 curved to the left. The cross-line of the A and H consists of a horizontal line having a curved termination upon the left and shaded above and below by the shorter horizontal lines. The upper right terminations of the 25 C, E, F, and G are curved and terminate in the dot. This termination is also found in the J and S at the base upon the left, in the L at the base upon the right, in the upper right termination of the S, in both the upper termi-30 nations of the T, and in both terminations of the Z at top and bottom. The lower righthand termination of the K is shaded on each side by the short inclined lines. The faces of the M, N, O, Q, U, V, and W are ornamented by the 35 short horizontal lines. The X is ornamented upon the right hand by a short inclined line proceeding from about the center of the letter. The Y is ornamented upon the right hand by a short inclined line proceeding from about

40 the center of the letter.

The character of the design is preserved in the lower-case and in the numerals.

Having now described my invention, I claim as new-

The design for a font of printing-type, the 45 same consisting of an ornamental letter, as herein shown and described, the upper portions of all the letters except the B, C, D, G, P, R, and S ornamented by the short horizontal lines, the B, C, D, P, and R having the upper por- 50 tion ornamented by a curved line, proceeding in the B, D, P, and R from the up and down portion of the letter and curved to the right, and in the C from the upper right hand portion and curved to the left, the cross-lines of 55 the A and H consisting of a horizontal line having a curved termination upon the left and shaded above and below by a shorter horizontal line, the upper right termination of the C, E, F, and G curved and terminating in a 50 dot, this termination also found in the J and S at the base upon the left, in the Lat the base upon the right, in the upper right termination of the S, in both the upper terminations of the T, and in both terminations of the Z at 65 top and bottom, the lower right termination of the K shaded on each side by a short inclined line, the faces of the M, N, O, Q, U, V, and W ornamented by the short horizontal lines, the X ornamented upon the right hand 70 by a short inclined line proceeding from about the center of the letter, the Y ornamented upon the right hand by a short inclined line proceeding from about the center of the letter. and the character of the design preserved in 75 the lower-case and numerals.
